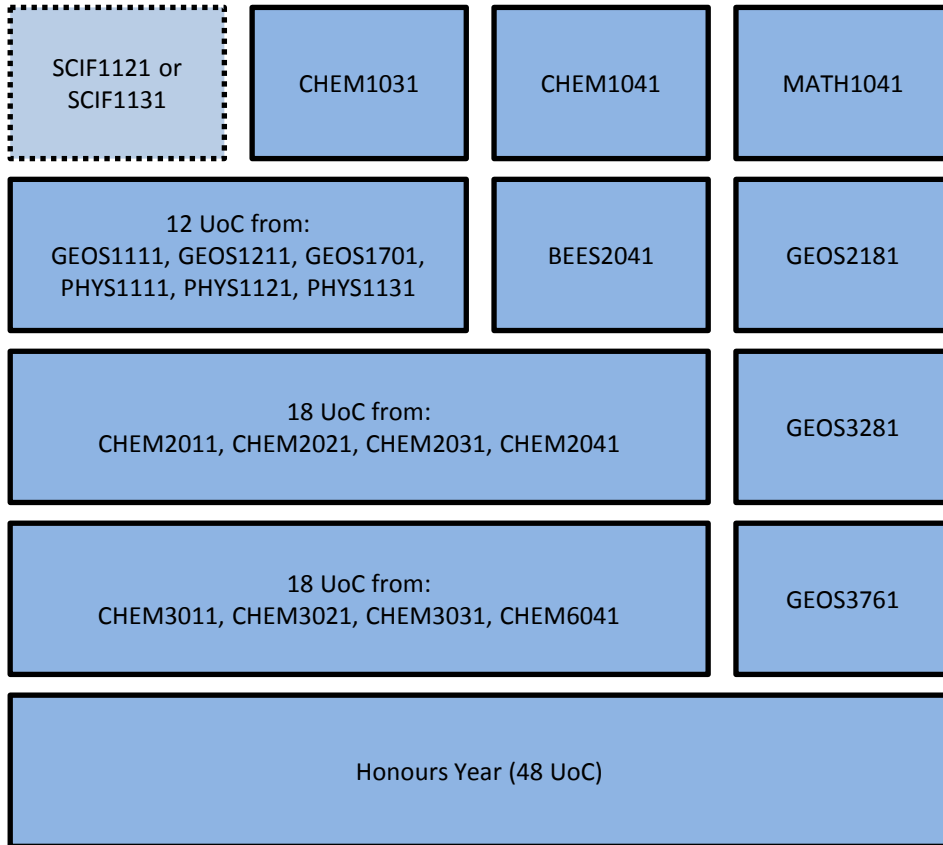


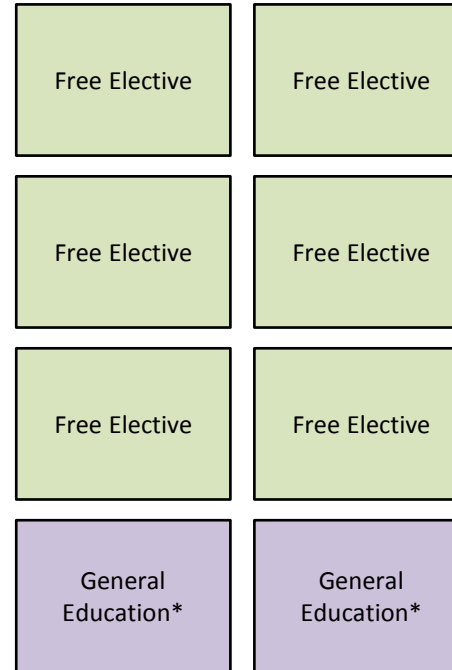


# 3972 Bachelor of Science (Advanced Science) with a major in Geochemistry

## Breadth (48 UoC)



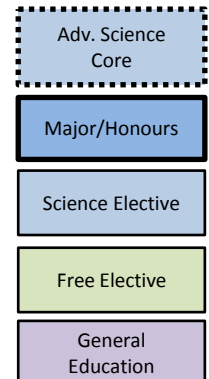
Breadth component is not completed when students undertake a dual degree program.

**\*General Education:**

Students cannot take 'Science' or GEN\$ courses for their General Education electives.

## Rules

- The Geochemistry major is 90 UoC
- The Adv. Science Core is comprised of 'Science' courses so that the *major + SCIF + 'Science' electives + Honours = 144 UoC*
- Students must declare their major before enrolling in Level 2 courses
- Students must complete at least 24 UoC of 'Science' Level 1 courses
- In the single degree, students cannot complete more than 72 UoC of Level 1 courses, including any GEN\*#### courses or mainstream Level 1 courses taken for General Education
- Students must complete at least 30 UoC of 'Science' Level 3 courses
- Students may use their Science and/or free electives to complete a double major
- Free electives may be from Science or from any other Faculty at UNSW



**Single Degree Program = 192 UoC (144 UoC Core + 48 UoC Breadth)**
