Students who complete the **Singapore Polytechnic College diplomas** below, and apply to the **Bachelor of Aviation (Flying)** or **Bachelor of Aviation (Management)** at UNSW Australia, may be eligible for advanced standing.

Credit of up to **48 Units of Credit (UoC)** or 8 courses (equivalent to 1 year) will be awarded to eligible students who achieve a minimum **CGPA of 2.4 out of 4**. This CGPA will be assessed on a regular basis and may be subject to change.
